ORDER:

Learned Public Prosecutor placed on record the written instructions dated 02-01-2020 submitted by the Sub-Inspector of Police, Abids Police Station and the same is made as part of the record. From a perusal of the same, it is revealed that the investigation was completed, final report was filed before the concerned Magistrate and it was numbered as C.C.No.21315 of 2019. In view of the same, the subject matter in the Criminal Petition has become infructuous.
