COMMON ORDER: (ORAL)

Mr. Gajanand Chakravarthi, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that subject matter of these writ petitions is squarely covered by a common order passed by this Court in W.P.No.34806 of 2022 and batch dated 21.09.2022, as such, these writ petitions may be disposed of in terms thereof, and the same is not disputed by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home.
