ORDER:

1. Aggrieved by the Judgment dated 26.07.2010 passed in Cr1.A.No.27 of 2010, on the file of the Court of Principal Sessions Judge, Khammam, the present Criminal Appeal is filed before this Court.

2. Learned counsel on record for the appellant has informed the Court that he had given up vakalat. This Court therefore directed the Registry to send notice to the appellant.
