CRIMINAL REVISION CASE No. 1994 OF 2010

ORDER:

This Criminal Revision Case is filed aggrieved by the order dated 27-09-2010 passed in M.C.No. 40 of 2009 on the file of the Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge for the Trial of JHBBC-cum-Additional Family Court-cum-XXIII Additional Chief Judge, Hyderabad.
