CONTEMPT CASE No.1979 of 2022

ORDER:

This Contempt Case is filed to summon the respondents and punish them for willful disobedience of the orders passed by this Court in W.P.No.11589 of 2022 dt.15-03-2022.

2. Learned Standing Counsel for Municipalities submits that the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner, on conduct of enquiry by the Enquiry Officer, has been dropped as the same are not proved vide letter dt.08-09-2022 as forwarded by the Enquiry Officer to the Commissioner of Greater Hyderabad Municipality.

3. In view of the submission made, since the Enquiry Officer had recorded his findings dropping the disciplinary proceedings, the respondent-authorities are directed to give effect to the said proceedings as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four (04) weeks from the date hereof, since it is contended by the petitioner that showing the pendency of disciplinary proceedings, the respondent-authorities have not settled his retirement benefits till date, though the petitioner had retired way back in 2016.

4. Subject to the above directions, this Contempt Case is closed. No costs.

5. As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
