ORDER:

Challenge in this Civil Revision Petition is the judgment and decree of the Andhra Pradesh State Waqf Tribunal, Hyderabad in OS.No.18 of 2012, dated 29.6.2015.

No representation on petitioner's side on call. On 17.12.2021, 29.3.2022, 06.4.2022 and 29.4.2022 time was sought by the learned counsel for the petitioner and obliging his request, time was granted.
