Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to enlarge the petitioners/Accused No.2 and 3 on bail in event of arrest in F.I.R.NO.224 OF 2022 dated 09-10-2022 on the File of the P.S.Gadwal Town of Jogulamba Gadwal District.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G RAJESHWAR RAO, Advocate for the Petitioners and of the Additional Public Prosecutor for the State of Telangana on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None Appeared for the Respondent No.2

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION No. 9787 OF 2022****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioners Nos. 2 and 3 who are arrayed as accused Nos.1 and 2 in the event of their arrest in Crime No.224 of 2022 on the file of Station House Officer, Gadwal Town Police Station, Jogulamba Gadwal District registered for the offences punishable under Sections 452, 427, 324, 504 read with read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3(i) ® (s) 3(2) (v) (a) SC/ST (POA) Amendment 2015.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State. Perused the record.

3. The case against the petitioners is that they along with accused No.1 trespassed into the premises of the *de facto* complainant and caused grievous hurt to him.

4. The Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that accused No.1 was arrested. Keeping in view the allegations in the present case, this Court is not inclined to grant relief of anticipatory bail. However, the petitioner if so advised to surrender before the concerned Court within one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order by filing an application seeking regular bail and upon such surrender the concerned Court shall dispose off the bail application on the very same day on merits after giving opportunity to the learned Public Prosecutor.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, pending shall stand closed.
