This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), 1973 seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner-Accused in the event of his arrest in Crime No.670 of 2022 on the file of Station House Officer, Chaitanyapuri Police Station, Rachakonda District registered for the offence punishable under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner-Accused and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State. Perused the record.

3. Since the punishment prescribed for the offences alleged against the petitioner are up to seven years, without going into the merits of the matter, the respondent-Police are directed to carry out the investigation by following the procedure as contemplated under Section 41-A Cr.P.C and the guidelines formulated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of ***Arnesh Kumar v. State of***

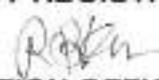
*Bihar*<sup>1</sup>scrupulously. It is needless to say, any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously.
