Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the order dt.26/10/2022 in CrI.M.P.No. 145 of 2022 in M.C.No.18/2019 on the file of Family Court-Cum-III Additional District and Sessions Court at Nizamabad and permit the petitioner to pay monthly maintenance of Rs.5000/- only to his son from the date of the order dated 22-07-2022 in CrI.Mp.No.100/2019 in M.C.No.18/2019

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner-respondent seeking to set aside the order dated 26.10.2022 passed in Crl.MP No.146 of 2022 in M.C.No.18 of 2019 by the learned Judge, Family Court-cum-III Additional District and Sessions Court, Nizamabad.

2. Heard both sides. Perused the material on record.
3. The petitioner is questioning the correctness of the order of the learned Judge, Family Court in directing this petitioner to pay the arrears of interim maintenance from the date of petition which would be for 27 months.
4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner – respondent to pay the half of the arrears of interim maintenance within a period of four months from the date of this order and the remaining half shall be paid subject to the outcome in the main petition.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed off.
