Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT Of MANDAMUS, declaring the action of the 2nd Respondent in not allowing the Petitioner bearing roll No. 4202030568 to upload application claiming NRI Quota for Admission Into UG Medical Courses(MBBS) under Minority Quota 2022-23 for TS UG Medical Admission-2022 and consequently, directing the 2nd Respondent to issue an Application to the Petitioner bearing roll No. 4202030568 claiming NRI Quota for Admission into UG Medical (MDBS)Courses under NRI Quota 2022-23 for TS PG Medical Admission-2022.

Writ Petition No.44621 of 2022

ORDER : *(Per Hon'ble Justice Abhinand Kumar Shavili)*

This Writ Petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a *Writ of Mandamus* to declare the action of 2nd respondent in not allowing the petitioner (bearing Roll No.4202030568) to upload application claiming for Admission into Under-Graduate Medical Courses (M.B.B.S.) under N.R.I. / Minority Quota 2022-23 for Telangana State Under-Graduate Medical Admission, 2022; and consequently, to direct the 2nd respondent to issue an application to the petitioner (bearing Roll No. 4202030568) claiming for admission into Under-Graduate Medical (M.B.B.S.) Courses under N.R.I. Quota 2022-23 for T.S. U.G. Medical Admission - 2022.

2. Heard Mr.A.P. Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner; the learned Government Pleader for Medical and Health for the 1st respondent; and Mr. A. Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, for the 2nd respondent-University.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has appeared for National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Examination, 2022 (Under-Graduate) and secured a decent rank; thereafter, the 2nd respondent-University has issued a notification dated 19.10.2022 inviting on-line applications for admission into "B" Category and Management Quota seats; pursuant to the said notification, petitioner has got registered under "B" Category and Management quota seats, but petitioner could not get registered for N.R.I. Category seat owing to various difficulties; in those set of circumstances, petitioner has submitted a representation to the 2nd respondent-University on 10.12.2022, requesting the 2nd respondent-University to permit the petitioner to upgrade

her status for N.R.I. in the application form; but, so far the 2nd respondent-University has not passed any orders on the said representation; and therefore, prayed this Court to pass appropriate orders in the Writ Petition by directing the 2nd respondent-University to consider the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 10.12.2022 and pass appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law.

4. On the other hand, learned Standing Counsel for the 2nd respondent-University submitted that since petitioner's representation dated 10.12.2022 is pending with the 2nd respondent-University, the 2nd respondent-University would consider the same and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

5. This Court, having considered the submissions made by the parties, is of the considered view that the present Writ Petition can be disposed of by directing the 2nd respondent-University to consider the representation dated 10.12.2022 submitted by the petitioner and pass

appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law within a reasonable period of time.

6. With these observations, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

7. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending if any in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed.
