This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Syed Osman, Advocate for the Petitioner and of the Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None appeared for the Respondent No. 2

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION No.11094 OF 2022****ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners-Accused Nos.2 and 3 seeking to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.2034 of 2020 pending on the file of XXIII Metropolitan Magistrate at Medchal, Cyberabad. The offences alleged against them are under Sections 498-A and 354-A of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners-Accused Nos.2 and 3 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent - State. Perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners confined his prayer to dispense with the personal appearance of petitioners - Accused Nos.2 and 3. He further submitted that the petitioner No.2 - Accused No.3 is aged about 66 years, due to which she is facing difficulty in attending the Court on every date of hearing.

4. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, the attendance of the petitioners – Accused Nos.2 and 3 is dispensed with in C.C.No.2034 of 2020 pending on the file of XXIII Metropolitan Magistrate at Medchal, Cyberabad, when represented by their counsel on record. The attendance of the petitioners – Accused Nos.2 and 3 is dispensed subject to filing affidavits by the petitioners stating that in their absence the proceedings conducted by their counsel will not be disputed by them in any manner and shall not dispute their identity also. However, the petitioners shall appear before the learned Magistrate as and when their presence is required. In the event of failure of the petitioners to appear when the Court directs, this order dispensing their attendance shall stand cancelled.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
