WRIT PETITION No.46571 of 2022

ORDER:

Heard Sri P. Venkateshwer Rao, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents. Perused the record.

Petitioners herein are claiming right over the lands in Sy.Nos.192 and 273 situated at Iydhru Dhonala Thanda, H/o.Rachakonda village, Narayanpur mandal, Yadadri-Bhongir District. In proof of the same, they have filed copies of old passbooks. According to them, they have submitted representation through an association seeking issuance of E-passbooks with respondent No.2. Despite receiving and acknowledging the said written representation, respondent No.2 did not act upon the same, therefore, the present writ petition.

Whereas learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, would submit that as per CCLA's Circular No.1/2021, dated 15-01-2021 the petitioners herein have to file online application to respondent No.2, who intturn, will consider the said online application submitted by the petitioners and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid discussion, this writ petition is disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioners to submit online application in terms of the aforesaid Circular to respondent No.2 along with relevant documents with a request to issue E-patteddar pass books. On receipt of the said online application, respondent No.2 shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders strictly in accordance with law by putting the petitioners and all affected parties on notice and affording them an opportunity of hearing. If respondent No.2 is not inclined to accept the claim / request of the petitioners, he shall assign specific

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reasons, pass a reasoned order and shall communicate copy of the said order to the petitioners. He shall complete the entire exercise within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of making of online application. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall stand closed.
