Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No. 3 to 5 in non-considering the online application of the Petitioner dated 10/10/2022 and non-initiating to issue E Pattadhar Pass Book to the Petitioner on her cultivating land to an extent of Ac. 2-20 Gts in Sy. No. 342/5Ee which is situated at Vallala revenue village shivar of Saligouraram Mandal, Nalgonda District is highly illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violation of Articles 14, 15, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and also violation of the Principles of Natural Justice and consequently direct the Respondent No. 3 to 5 to issue E Pattadhar Pass Books to the Petitioner on her cultivating land to an extent of Ac. 2-20 Gts in Sy. No. 342/5Ee which is situated at Vallala revenue village shivar of Saligouraram Mandal, Nalgonda District;

WRIT PETITION No.46605 of 2022

ORDER:

Heard Sri Rapolu Bhaskar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents. Perused the record.

Petitioner is claiming that she is the absolute owner and possessor of land admeasuring Ac.2-20 gts., in Sy.No.342/5Ec situated at Vallala revenue village shivar of Saligouraram mandal, Nalgonda District. In proof of the same, she has filed copies of old pattedar passbook. She has submitted online application bearing No.LM2200036756 dated 10-11-2022 with respondent No.3 with a request to issue E-pattedar passbook. Despite receiving and acknowledging the said online application, respondent No.3 did not act upon the same, therefore, the present writ petition.

Whereas learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, would submit that respondent No.3 will consider the said online application submitted by the

petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid discussion, this writ petition is disposed of, directing respondent No.3 to dispose of the online application bearing No.LM2200036756 dated 10-11-2022 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law by putting the petitioner and all affected parties on notice and affording them an opportunity of hearing. If respondent No.3 is not inclined to accept the claim/ request of the petitioner, he shall assign specific reasons, pass a reasoned order and shall communicate copy of the said order to the petitioner. He shall complete the entire exercise within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall stand closed.
