Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order of direction, preferably one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus and to declare the action of the respondents by putting a condition in Guideline No.22 in sub para 3 in the Appendix in the G.O.Ms.No.317, dt. 6-12-2021, treating only widows appointed under the Compassionate Appointments Scheme as special category of employees and accommodating on preferential basis regardless of seniority, while excluding all other widows such as petitioner and allotting her to other

District far of from her place of native denying the petitioner of equal opportunity of being considered under special category of employees as being widow, and impugned allotment proceedings No. WD/WO/ZVIII/EXOF/0225, dt. 27.12.2021 as illegal without jurisdiction, violative of Art. 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same by further directing the respondents to consider the petitioner, widow employee as special category employee under para 22 in Appendix-II in G.O.Ms.No.317, dt. 6-12-2021 and allot her to ICDS project, Quthbullapur, Medchal district Zone - VI or continue the petitioner in the same place Zone VI as per her preference with all consequential benefits.

Heard Mr. P.Rajesh, learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Petitioner was working as Extension Officer/Supervisor, Grade-I, Zone-VI, Patancheru Project in Sanga Reddy District. However, by virtue of G.O.Ms.No.317 dated 06.12.2021, she was transferred and allotted to Zone-III in Siddipet District. In this connection, petitioner has filed appeal dated 29.12.2021 requesting that she may posted in ICDS Project, Siddipet, Siddipet District for the grounds and reasons mentioned in the appeal.

3. The said appeal is yet to be considered.

4. On due consideration, we direct 1st respondent to consider the appeal of the petitioner dated 29.12.2021 and

thereafter pass an appropriate order in accordance with law, which shall be intimated to the petitioner. The above exercise shall be carried out within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

6. Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this Writ Petition shall stand closed.
