ORDER:

Heard Sri K. Rama Subba Rao, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondents. Perused the record.

Petitioner herein had filed an appeal under Section 24 of A.P. (Telangana Area) Abolition of Inams Act, 1955, on 21-11-2022, with respondent No.3 challenging the order dated 11-10-2022 of respondent No.4. Despite receiving and acknowledging the said appeal, respondent No.3 did not act upon the same, therefore, the present writ petition.

Whereas learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, would submit that respondent No.3 will register the said appeal and dispose of it, in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid discussion, this writ petition is disposed of, directing respondent No.3 to register the aforesaid appeal by assigning number and dispose of the same by strictly following due procedure laid down under law, as expeditiously as possible. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall stand closed.
