ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioners- Accused Nos.2 and 3 to quash the proceedings against them in FIR No.832 of 2022 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Women Police Station, DD, Hyderabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A of I.P.C and Sections 3, 4 of D.P.Act.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners – Accused Nos.2, 3 and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent No.1 – State. Perused the material on record.

3. A perusal of the record would reveal that the disputes are outcome of marital discord in between 2nd respondent-*de facto* complainant and accused No.1. The petitioners herein are the parent of accused No.1.

4. In the said circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the Investigating Officer in FIR No.832 of 2022 pending on the file of Station House Officer, Women Police Station, DD, Hyderabad, to conclude the investigation without taking any coercive steps against the petitioners – Accused Nos.2 and 3. Further, the petitioners – Accused Nos.2 and 3 shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when required for the purpose of investigation.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
