Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of a writ of Mandamus under Article 226 of the Constitution of India,

- (i) declaring the action of the 1st Respondent in not including the name of the Petitioner in the Provisional Seniority List of Deputy Superintendents of Police between 02.06.2014 to 31.08.2021 issued in proceedings Rc.No.192/G3/2022, dated 25.11.2022 by the 1st Respondent and not considering the case of the Petitioner for promotion to the post of Addl. SP against the vacancy earmarked for ST (Women) under Rules 22, read with Rule 22-A of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules and considering the case of ST (Men) against such vacancy is arbitrary, illegal, discriminatory, malafide, unconstitutional, violating Articles 14, 16 21 of the Constitution of India apart from contrary to Rules 22, 22-A 33 of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules.
- (ii) and issue consequential directions directing the Respondents forthwith consider the case of the Petitioner for promotion to the post of Addl.

considering the case of the petitioner for promotion despite availability of vacancy for ST (Women) and also submits that the representation dated 29.11.2022 made by the petitioner is also not considered and it is still pending for consideration. But, in the meanwhile the seniority list is being prepared and the petitioner is not considered for unknown reasons.

3. On the other hand, learned Special Government Pleader submits that the seniority list has already been issued by the respondents and the case of the petitioner does not stand within the merit list and therefore the case of the petitioner is not considered and further submits that the representation dated 29.11.2022 made by the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law.

4. In view of the submissions made by both the counsels, this Court is inclined to direct the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 29.11.2022 in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within four (04) weeks from the date of

receipt of a copy of this order, taking into consideration of her earlier date of promotion and strictly in adherence with the rules prevailing as on today.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
6. Interlocutory applications, if any, pending in this writ petition, shall stand closed.

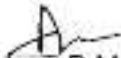
