ORDER (per AKS,J)

When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for the petitioners has informed the Court that during pendency of the Writ Petition, the sole respondent has retired from the service after attaining the age of superannuation and thus rendering the Writ Petition as infructuous.

Moreover, this Court has not suspended the operation of the impugned order passed by the A.P. Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad, which would mean that the order of the Tribunal has been worked out itself and on this ground also, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the orders of the Tribunal.
