When the matter was taken up for hearing, learned Government Pleader for Services appearing for the petitioners informed this Court that during the pendency of the case the respondent has retired from service and the writ petition can be closed as infructuous.

2. Learned Government Pleader for Services further contended that the Tribunal has directed for adhoc promotion and the order of the Tribunal may not come in the way of subsequent revision of the respondent.
