Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash C.C.No.257 of 2016 on the file of the Hon'ble Judicial First class Magistrate at Utnoor and consequentially all proceedings emanating from the same.

CRIMINAL PETITION No.10757 of 2018

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners - accused Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to quash the proceedings against them in C.C.No.257 of 2016 on the file of learned Judicial First Class Magistrate at Utnoor registered for the offence under Sections 447, 324, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. No representation on behalf of the petitioners.
3. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor has submitted that subsequent to filing of the criminal petition, the parties to the dispute have settled the matter before the Lok Adalath on 23.12.2018 and accordingly the trial Court has disposed of the case and to that extent letter dated 15.07.2022 addressed by the Sub-Inspector of Police, Neredmet Police Station to the Public Prosecutor of the High Court is filed.
4. In view of the above submissions, since the main case has already been disposed of, the very purpose of filing the criminal petition to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.257 of 2016 on the file of learned Judicial First Class Magistrate at Utnoor has

already been defeated and thereby the criminal petition has become infructuous and liable to be dismissed.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous Petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed.
