Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of Covid-19 Pandemic.

Petitioners allege that both of them are major and they got married on 31.12.2021 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 who are related to petitioner No.1, respondents No.7 who is related to petitioner No.2 and respondent No.8 who is Sarpanch of the village. This is their first marriage.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No.4 to 8 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 31.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S.Aulakh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in

accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to consider representation dated 31.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
