Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 submit that the application has been rendered infructuous on account of the fact that insolvency proceedings have been initiated and are pending against respondents No.2 and 3. It is submitted that a similar matter i.e. Arbitration Case No. 11 of 2018 *Mala Kumar Engineers Pvt. Ltd. vs. Isolux Corsan India C&C Join Venture and others*, filed under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, has already been withdrawn by the applicant on the ground that he wishes to submit his claim before the appropriate authorities/forum before whom the insolvency proceedings are pending.

Be that as it may, since none appeared on behalf of the petitioner, the petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
