Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.134 dated 03.12.2021, under Sections 323, 326-B, 341 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman, Police District Batala.

By virtue of the order dated 10.02.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaspal singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more

required for further investigation.
