The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63 dated 09.09.2021, registered under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC at Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 06.01.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Upon instructions from the concerned Investigating Officer, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.
