Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.60 dated 12.08.2021 registered under Section 306 of IPC, Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga, Punjab.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner who was sister-in-law of deceased Jasbir Singh along with other accused incited and abetted the deceased to commit suicide and resultantly deceased Jasbir Singh committed suicide.

The counsel for petitioner has apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the order of interim bail dated 07.01.2022 passed by this Court.

The State counsel on the instructions from SI Sewak Singh has admitted this fact and further stated that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

As has been admitted by the State Counsel the deceased had not left behind any suicide note. The petitioner is sister of wife of deceased and she has already joined the investigation.

In the light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order granting interim bail dated 07.01.2022 to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
