VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.86 dated 09.05.2019 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Samana, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 07.01.2020, it was noticed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court that in addition to respondent No.2, one Nachhatar Kaur has also sustained injuries in the occurrence and accordingly, the said Nachhatar Kaur was impleaded as respondent No.3 and notice was also issued to her but however, no one has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3

and even the compromise deed placed on record is also not signed by respondent No.3.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petition after entering into compromise with all the concerned persons and after placing on record the said compromise.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
