1. Pursuant to order dated 07.01.2020, copy of speaking order dated 28.02.2020, has been produced by the learned AAG, Punjab. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of speaking order dated 28.02.2020, having been passed, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but liberty be granted to the petitioner to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law for claiming interest on account of delay in release of financial benefits.

2. The same is not opposed to by the learned AAG, Punjab.

3. Admittedly, speaking order dated 28.02.2020, has been passed in compliance of order dated 25.02.2019, in CWP-4912-2019 and the petitioner has also been released financial benefits as per his entitlement in terms of order dated 28.02.2020, passed by respondent No.2

4. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
