Status report by way of affidavit of Pawan Sharma, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bahadurgarh has been filed on behalf of the State, the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

It has also been pointed out by learned State counsel that out of total 14 witnesses 07 prosecution witnesses have also been examined and that the case is pending before the Additional Session Judge, Jhajjar for 13.05.2022 for examination of the prosecution witnesses.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not press the instant petition and would be satisfied in case a direction be issued to the Additional Session Judge/trial Court to conclude the prosecution evidence expeditiously.

The aforesaid request made by learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by learned State counsel and he undertakes to conclude the prosecution evidence within a period of 04 months from the next date fixed for recording of the prosecution evidence before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Needless to mention that the prosecution shall make all necessary endeavour to conclude this evidence within a period of 04 months from the date next fixed for recording of the prosecution evidence.
