[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 21.08.2019 in CWP No.21898 of 2019 in case titled as Wilbert Samson vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.21898 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider representations dated 24.05.2018, 12.06.2018 and 01.08.2019 by keeping in view the contentions raised in the writ petition and treating the same as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order in respect thereto, in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the order violation of which has been complained of, has been complied with vide order dated 24.07.2020 and benefits admissible as per entitlement have been released to the petitioner, therefore, in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
