The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 58 dated
26.04.2021 under Sections 302, 148, 149, 201 and 120-B of the Indian
Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled
Tribe Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the
complainant have pointed out that the complainant as well as the eye
witness namely Chhinder Kaur, on whose statement, the present petitioner
has been implicated, have not been examined as yet.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks
permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage with

liberty to file a fresh petition for regular bail after the said complainant and eye witness namely Chhinder Kaur are examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.

It is made clear that in case if the fresh petition for regular bail would be filed, the same would be considered independently on its merits, in accordance with law.
