The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.09.2021 (Anenxure P-11) passed by respondent No.3 whereby the Brick Kiln License No.214-L issued in favour of the petitioner has been cancelled in total disregard to the provisions of the Punjab Control of Bricks Supplies, Price & Distribution Control Order, 1998; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the appeal against the impugned order passed against the petitioner, is already pending before respondent No.3. At this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the said appeal within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pawan Sharda, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner, as prayed for by the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to take a conscious decision upon the appeal filed by the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
