Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner on government job as per policy dated 08.11.2011 (P-1) & guidelines dated 03.03.2014 (P-2).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 23.12.2021 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with

direction to the respondents, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 23.12.2021 (P-10), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
