[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 10.09.2021, in CWP No.17963 of 2021 in case titled as '**M/s Khosla Enterprises** versus **The State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.17963 of 2021 was disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide legal notice dated 07.08.2021 within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and payment if any, found to be due to the petitioner, be released within six weeks thereafter.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner has been decided by the competent authority and payment as per entitlement determined therein, released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
