1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 09.07.2018, in CWP-16258-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 09.07.2018, reveals that CWP-16258-2018, was disposed of by directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 herein to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 14.05.2014, in accordance with law, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the amount due, to release the same to the petitioner forthwith.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3 has filed copy of order dated 24.02.2021, as per which payment of Rs.4,50,269/- has been made to the petitioner, vide cheque No.064027

same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge the action of the respondents in effecting recovery, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
