Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 89 dated 02.07.2020, under Sections 435, 336, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Arniwala, Tehsil and District Fazilka and and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 01.02.2022, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 24.02.2022 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Fazilka has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Fazilka. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between

the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any influence, threat and coercion.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 89 dated 02.07.2020, under Sections 435, 336, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Arniwala, Tehsil and District Fazilka along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
