[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to conduct Physical Screening Test of the petitioner on the basis of advertisement No.4 of 2020 dated 30.12.2020 as the petitioner has qualified the written test as well as Physical Screening Test as per criteria given in the advertisement.

[3] Learned State counsel has produced the result of the petitioner for Physical Screening Test vis-à-vis the race of 2.5 kilometers which was required to be completed in 12 minutes. Learned State counsel further, on instructions from Shri Ramnish Singla, ADA, HSSC states that as per the result, the petitioner instead of completing the aforementioned race in 12 minutes has completed the race in 12 minutes 05 seconds. In other words, the petitioner has not qualified the Physical

[4] Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail his remedy in accordance with law otherwise than by way of a writ petition.

[5] The same is not opposed to by the learned State counsel.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
