[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.09.2018, in CWP No.9613 of 2017.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.9613 of 2017, was disposed of vide order dated 25.09.2018 in terms of order of even date passed in 'Harish Kumar *versus* Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Patiala and others', CWP No.9391 of 2017.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment as per entitlement in terms of decision in CWP No.9613 of 2017 has been released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
