The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for placing on record medical record of the complainant as Annexure R-1.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and medical record of the complainant as Annexure R-1 is taken on record.

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The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing DDR No.3 dated 12.02.2019 in FIR No.41 dated 12.02.2019 registered under Sections 323 and 506 IPC (Sections 148, 149, 324 and 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Kunjpura, District Karnal.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions, the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 10.01.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
