Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.296 dated 5.10.2021 registered under Sections 379, 411, 201 IPC (Section 473 IPC added later on) at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police in compliance of order dated 10.1.2022 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court. This fact has not been refuted by the counsel for the State who made statement on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh to the effect that the petitioners are not required by the police for any custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 10.1.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
