Main case

[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.12.2015, in CWP No.8184 of 2013 in case titled as '**Anil Kumar and others** versus **State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.8184 of 2013, was disposed of vide order dated 22.12.2015, by setting aside the impugned orders and directing the official respondents to consider the candidatures of all the eligible candidates, who fulfilled the requisite qualifications / experience as per amended Rules of 2012 within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and to pass necessary orders accordingly.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, states that pursuant to the order (Annexure R-1) dated 01.07.2016, promotions of persons wrongly promoted to the post of Elementary School Head Masters were cancelled and said employees reverted to the post of Masters / C&Vs in the respective subjects, whereafter, the petitioners were promoted to the post of Elementary School Head Masters.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the needful having been done and the judgment of this Court, as contained in Annexure P-1 having been complied with, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
