[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the
respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated
18.11.2019, in CWP No.26332 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.26332
of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide
representation dated 19.08.2019 within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of
certified copy of the order and to take such further action in the matter
within 04 weeks thereafter, as may be warranted in the facts and
circumstances of the case pursuant to the decision of the representation.

[3] Learned counsel states that in view of speaking order
(Annexure R-1) dated 22.01.2020, rejecting the representation dated
19.08.2019, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant
petition in view of his already having challenged order (Annexure R-1)
dated 22.01.2020 by way of CWP No.32692-2019.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the challenge to order (Annexure R-1) dated 22.01.2020, in accordance with law.
