1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.09.2019, in CWP-23753-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-23753-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 02.09.2019, by directing the respondent to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of notice of demand dated 01.06.2019 and take a final decision thereon expeditiously and in any case within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case of finding any amount due/payable towards the petitioner, necessary funds be released to the petitioner without any delay.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case but compliance report was called for vide order dated 10.01.2020. However, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment as per entitlement has been made by the respondent to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances,

the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
