Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length prays for issuance of a direction to the respondents to direct the official respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 27.06.2021 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-6), by which the petitioner has brought to the notice of the respondent-authorities the fact that respondents No.11 to 19 had obtained the contracts on the basis of forged documents.

Learned Assistant Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab submits that the aforesaid representation dated 27.06.2021 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner shall be considered and decided by the respondent-authorities expeditiously in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, the petition stands disposed of.
