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**MANOJ BAJAJ, J.**

Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0035 dated 28.04.2021 under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur, who apprehend their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 07.01.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Learned counsel contends that the alleged occurrence between neighbours took place on 17.04.2021, whereas the FIR was lodged after a long delay on 28.04.2021 and except for the offence punishable under Section 452 IPC, the other offences are bailable. Learned counsel has further argued that a cross case has already been registered at the instance of Davinder Singh and the alleged occurrence took place in the street.*

*Notice of motion for 28.04.2022.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety*

*bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioners associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by HC Navjot Singh states that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.01.2022 is made absolute.
