By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is allegedly being harassed by respondent no.6 at the instance of respondent nos.7 and 8. He also seeks a direction to respondents no.2 and 5 to take a legal action on the representations dated 30.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) and 16.12.2021 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation made to the Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, dated 16.12.2021 (copy Annexure P-5), is looked into and decided on merits, with action to be taken accordingly.

That being so, even though learned counsel for respondents no.7 and 8 is present without notice having been issued in this petition, without making any comment whatsoever on the contents of what is stated either in this petition or in the representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab (respondent no.2), to go into the representation of the petitioner and to take any action as may be required as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
