[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-6, dated 17.09.2019 in CWP No.10638 of 2019 in case titled as Srishta Devi and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and Ors..

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/6 reveals that CWP No.10638 of 2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider legal notice dated 25.07.2018 and take necessary action in respect thereto in accordance with law within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 14.02.2020 deciding the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 25.07.2018, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 14.02.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not

calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
