1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.02.2019, in CWP No. 3562-2019, in case titled as Satish Kumar Kapil vs. Haryana Urban Development Authority and others.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No. 3562 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into the grievance as set out in the legal notice and take a decision thereon, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Short reply by way of affidavit of Smt. Jaspreet Kaur,

filed in court today by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. A perusal of the reply reveals the stand therein that in case the petitioner applies for user ID and password, the same shall be provided after examination of the application.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for issuance of directions to the respondents to decide the application filed by the petitioner for issuance of user ID and password for transfer of plot in his favour and for issuance of re-allotment letter in a time bound manner, in view of the order allegedly passed by the respondent on 23.11.2020 to the above effect not having been conveyed to the petitioner till date.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent states that in case any application is moved by the petitioner for issuance of user ID and password, the same shall be decided and action in respect thereto taken in accordance with law within two weeks from the date of receipt of the application. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, as well as the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for issuance of user ID and password for transfer of plot in his favour and for issuance of re-allotment letter, besides directing

the respondents that in case of receipt of any application as referred to above, the same be considered and decided and if entitled to, the petitioner be issued user ID and password within a period of 02 weeks from the date of filing of the application.
