Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay the arrears which are payable to the petitioner for the last 14 years of her service long with interest @ 18% per annum till the payment of such arrears and to release the documents of the car bearing registration No. CH-01-AY-2031

with signed transfer letter which was purchased by the petitioner in terms of the policy bearing No. RBGI/REG/09/2485 dated 26.10.2009 (Annexure P-8) to enable the petitioner to get the vehicle transferred in her name.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 25.10.2021 (Annexure P-15) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
