In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 07.03.2022 status report of the investigation by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barara, District Ambala, dated 06.04.2022 has been submitted in the Registry, which is taken on record. In para-4 of the said affidavit, it has been stated as follows:-

“That it is relevant to submit here that the cancellation report prepared by the SHO, PS Barara in case FIR No.16 dated 08.02.2017 under Section 279/304-A IPC PS Barara was submitted before the competent authority and the same has been approved by the competent authority i.e. The Superintendent of Police, Ambala on 22.03.2022 and thereafter, on 25.03.2022, the cancellation report

has been submitted before the Ld. Court of Ms. Nidhi Beniwal, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala which has been adjourned for 21.04.2022 for notice to complainant. The copy of order dated 25.03.2022 passed by the Ld. Court of Ms. Nidhi Beniwal, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala is annexed as Annexure R-1.”

In light of the above, when the case is pending before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala for further consideration on submission of the report for 13.06.2022, no further orders are required to be passed in the present appeal. It would, however, be open to the complainant to pursue the matter before the Court where the cancellation report is pending for consideration.

The present appeal stands disposed of.
