Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.439 dated 19.12.2020, under Section 18A, 18(C), 27, 28 of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, Section 22(C), 61 NDPS Act, Police Station, Saran, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that marriage of the petitioner's sister, namely, Neha has to be solemnized on 22.1.2022, and being an elder brother, certain ceremonies have to be performed by him. In this regard, a copy of wedding card has been annexed as Annexure P-2. He prays that the petitioner be released on interim bail till 27.1.2022.

On 17.1.2022, learned State counsel sought time to verify the ground raised by the petitioner. Today, he has produced the police report dated 18.01.2022 by the SHO, Police Station Saran, Faridabad and submitted that indeed the marriage of petitioner's sister is to be performed on 22.1.2022.

Considering the above ground raised for interim bail as well as

the report submitted by the State, this Court finds that the limited prayer made by the petitioner deserves acceptance.

Resultantly, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on interim bail for a week in the above case, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.

The petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the concerned Jail Authorities on 25.1.2022, before 5.00 p.m.
